A FEW KEY TEACHINGS OF THE APOSTLES' DOCTRINE:

GOD'S WORD IN THE NEW COVENANT

We believe that Jesus Christ and the Word of God are inseparable. To reject any of God's Word is to reject Christ. Therefore, we believe in the protection and propagation of the unadulterated Word of God. We esteem the Scriptures above all else and believe all people must submit to the authority of God's Word to be saved. We affirm there is one doctrine once delivered to the saints and known as the apostles' doctrine. We uphold these standards with love, mercy and patience (Psalm 138:2; Isaiah 66:1-2; John 1:1,14,6:63; Acts 2:42; 1Timothy 4:16; 2Timothy 2:2,3:16-17; Jude 3).

BIBLICAL ORDER

We believe that the restoration of the apostles and prophets and collective body ministry is vital to maturing and uniting the body of Christ (Acts 2:46; 1Corinthians 12:28,14:29-32; Ephesians 2:20,4:11-16).

UNITY

We are striving for true biblical unity by pulling down demonic and worldly strongholds that separate the body of Christ including sectarianism, doctrinal differences, race, culture, gender, traditions, social-economic status, etc. to form one new man from Jewish and Gentile believers. (John 17:20-23; 2Corinthians 10:4-6; Ephesians 2:11-11; Philippians 2:1-16).

BIBLICAL FAITH AND LOVE

We teach that biblical faith and love both involve an active response to the Word of God, which means consistently learning and obeying God's Word so that each disciple will demonstrate sacrificial love as Christ did. (Matthew 7:21-26,28:20; John 14:15,23-24,15:12,16:9-14; 1Thessalonians 1:3; Hebrews 3:12-19,10:26-31; James 2:1-26; 1John 5:3).

MATURITY

We believe that all disciples are commanded to "be Christ" in this world. Jesus Christ is the Word of God made flesh. Therefore, all disciples must become "the Word of God." This is accomplished as disciples learn and obey God's Word. We are committed to lovingly teach God's Word to all disciples and guide them to obey it so they can mature to "become Christ" in the world (Matthew 5:48; John 14:12; Romans 8:29; 2Corinthians 3:18,4:4-6; Galatians 2:20; Ephesians 4:13-16,5:1-33,6:1-18; Philippians 3:7-15; Hebrews 5:12-14,6:1-12).
